Dr. Ka-Fai To, Professor, Anatomical & Cellular Pathology Department, The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK), HKSAR.

Dr To was graduated from The Chinese University of Hong Kong. He received pathology training in the Anatomical and Cellular Pathology (ACP) Department, Prince of Wales Hospital, HKSAR and obtained the pathologist fellowship qualification in Hong Kong and Australasia (FHKCPATH, FHKAM(Path), FRCPA). Being a practicing pathologist, he received Pediatric pathology subspecialty training in Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children, London, UK. Dr. To currently is the Chairman of Anatomical & Cellular Pathology (ACP) Department, The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) and Honorary Chief of Service (COS) in ACP, Prince of Wales Hospital, HKSAR. He is the Associate Director of Partner State Key Laboratory in Oncology in South China (CUHK) and Investigator of Partner State Key Laboratory in Digestive Disease (CUHK). He awarded the Outstanding Fellow of The Faculty of Medicine. He also served as the Director of the Pathology Teaching Laboratory. Dr To is supervisor for PhD students and post-doctoral fellows, currently four of his PhD students are appointed at Assistant/ Associate Professor rank.

Dr. To's research interest includes common Asian Cancers and Molecular diagnostic. He also served as advisory board member for various Pharmaceutical industries. He currently served in the Pathology Committee in the International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer (IASLC) and participates in the recent WHO classification of Lung Tumors. Dr. To is the author or co-author of ~420 international peer-reviewed indexed articles with H-index 68 (ISI Web of science).
