



Johnson and Johnson Thoracic Surgery Student Scholarship

This prize and scholarship aims to offer an opportunity for final medical year students to attend an international conference and gain further insight into the academic and research developments in surgery, and in particular foster their interest in the field of thoracic surgery.

Selection Criteria:

Interested candidate should write an article between 1500-2000 words on the subject of "The Future of Thoracic Surgery". The article will be rated according to (1) originality; (2) understanding on the current problems and issues in the specialty; and (3) arguments for why their solutions and vision of the future would be favoured. The article may focus on a specific disease or procedure related to thoracic surgical practice, or a broader look at the specialty as a whole.

Submission:

The article should be submitted to the Department through email: surgery@surgery.cuhk.edu.hk on or before the last day of April.

Result:

All articles will be reviewed by relevant CUHK professor(s) or other invited internationally well-known Thoracic surgeon(s). The awardee would be selected and judged by them. Announcement will be made around end of June.

Award:

The awardee will receive a scholarship HK\$8,000 and additional HK\$12,000 funding for supporting the expenses (i.e. economy class round trip air-ticket, hotel accommodation and registration fee) to attend the congress / symposium in Cardiothoracic Surgery in Asia: (1) Asian Society for Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery (ASCVTS) Annual Meeting; or (2) Association of Thoracic and Cardiovascular Surgeons of Asia (ATCSA) Annual Meeting; or (3) other conference / meeting accepted by the sponsor; within 1 year from the date being awarded.
